Welcome to the Moffat MRT Annual Charity Challenge This year we are exploring the Durisdeer Hills The Maps covering this area are OS Landranger 78 or Explorer 329

BBQ and Refreshments will be available at Durisdeermill Hall following the walks.

For all walks please register at Durisdeermill Hall GR NS 884 041

Walk 1: A Guided walk suitable for children. All walkers will be transported from Durisdeer Mill Hall to Durisdeer Village. Walking a short distance up the original Roman road, before taking a rough track to the Roman Fortlet an original Roman toll route to Edinburgh. There is a burn crossing, therefore wellies and waterproofs are recommended for the children. Weather permitting the fort is an excellent place for a picnic lunch/snack (please bring your own). A children's treasure hunt around the fort is planned. Walkers return to Durisdeer via the same route. Transport from the village back to the Hall is available. For those families who would like to extend the route they can walk back to Durisdeer Mill Hall.

Start Time: 1100 from Durisdeermill Hall

Distance approx 3 km - Durisdeer village to Roman Fort and back. An additional 1.6k back to Durisdeer Mill Hall

Please register by 1030

Walk 2: A moderate level route with gentle ascents and descents, along a hard track. Walkers will be transported up the starting point just beyond Troloss Farm on the A702.

Following the track and picking up the roman road which is of significant historical importance, from the roman road you can see the Roman Fortlet an original toll point. Descending down to Durisdeer village, walking by road and track down to the Durisdeer

Start Time: 1030 from A702 near Troloss farm

Distance approx 8 Km Please register by 1000

Walk 3: A challenging route, previous hill walking experience is required. Walkers leave Durisdeermill Hall (130m) on foot. Follow the road and track up to Durisdeer cemetery (close to Durisdeer village). Stay on a hard track, a steady climb up to the bothy at Kettleton Byre (330m) and on up to the summit of Glenleith Fell (612m). Past the Smuring Hags leaving the hard track follow close to the fence line on the quad track to Scaw'd Law (663m). Before heading north west to Little Scaw'd Law (594m) and then onto Durisdeer Hill (569m), descending to Durisdeer Village and then following a road and track to Durisdeermill Hall.

Start Time: 0915 from Durisdeermill Hall

Distance approx 15.5 Km

Please register by 0845

Walk 4: A strenuous walk for more experienced walkers following the route of an old drove road. Some parts of the walk can be quite boggy and wet underfoot. You will be transported from Durisdeermill Hall to Kirkhope Cleuch Cottage, on the shore of Daer Reservoir. From here you will head up Watchman's Brae (594m) then onto Roger Law (688m) and then to the high point of the day on Ballencleuch Law (689m). From here you will follow the fence south west to the summit of Scaw'd Law (663m). Retracing your steps to the fence junction you will then head north west to Little Scaw'd Law (594m). Then onto Durisdeer Hill (569m) before descending to Durisdeer Village and then following a road and track to Durisdeermill Hall. Distance approx: 12 Km
